3.(i) Fees structure similar to that of the academic session 2019-20 is need to be implemented in session 2022-23 with some necessary modifications. The FY 2022-23 Budget is prepared accordingly. The course-wise admission fees to be deposited at the time of admission for admission in 2022-23 academic session :: BA Honours Rs.3340/-, BA Programme Rs. 2890/-, BSc Honours Rs. 4850/-, B Sc Programme Rs. 3400/-, Honours in Lib & Information Studies (Proposed Self financed)- Rs. 6690/-, Honours in Environmental Science (Proposed Self financed) -Rs. 7150/- and MA in History(proposed Self financed) Rs. 4110/- Excursion & Lab fees of lab & excursion oriented subjects are extra. Only tuition fee is payable in even semesters. The Bankura University fees will be collected as per instruction from the University from time to time.

The Principal informs the house that a number of compliances, based on audited reports of earlier years (till FY 2019-20), are needed to implement. Some heads are required to modify for better financial management & accounting purpose and finally in auditing by DPI nominated Chattered accountant. The meeting of the Admission Sub-committee of Sonamukhi College is held today (15/07/2022) at 12:00 Noon in the office of the Principal to discuss the agenda mentioned in the notice (Admission procedure for the upcoming session 2022-23 and miscellaneous, if any). Honorable Principal, Dr. Bappaditya Mandal presided over the meeting. After a detailed discussion over the matter by all the present members, the following resolutions are taken anonymously.

- Admission to different courses in B.A./B.Sc./B.Com 1st semester for the Academic Session 2022-23 will be conducted strictly maintaining the guidelines set in the order No. 507 - Edn(CS)/IOM-95/14 dated 30th June 2022 issued by the Higher Education Department, Govt. of West Bengal and the guidelines issued in BKU/FCUG/ 92 /2022 dated 7th July 2022 by Bankura University.
- As decided in the previous meeting it is resolved that the software developed by MSS will be used in the Online Admission procedure for the session 2022-23.
- It is resolved that the subject wise division of total intake capacity for Arts Programme course in the Academic Session 2022-23 will be as follows.
Bengali Programme- 181, Philosophy Programme- 181, Education Programme-181, History Programme- 42, Pol. Sc. Programme- 29, Sanskrit Programme- 19, English Programme- 11, Economics Programme- 11, Geography Programme- 29, Physical Education Programme- 107.
- It is resolved that an applicant will be allowed to apply for a maximum of four Honours Courses and a maximum of two Programme Courses during the registration procedure. Also, candidates will get a maximum of two chances for transferring their choices after admitting to a particular course.
- It is resolved that the Online registration process will start from 18th September 2022 and will continue up to 5th August 2022. The Provisional merit list will be published on 10th August 2022. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th merit lists will be published on 16-08-2022, 19-08-2022, 22-08-2022, 25-08-2022, 29-08-2022, 02-09-2022 and 06-09-2022 respectively, depending on the availability of subject wise and category wise seats. The college may publish the next merit lists depending on the situation. However, the above schedule may be changed due to some technical issues, orders from the Bankura University and the State Government (if any), etc.
- It is also resolved that if a particular merit list gets exhausted and some seats still remain empty in the corresponding subject (maintaining category), that particular merit list may be repeated within that stipulated time.
- It was observed that Samar Ali Khan, Non-teaching staff of this college, remained involved with the admission procedure last year in many ways. So, It is resolved that Samar Ali Khan will be involved with the admission procedure this year also. He will help the committee members as and when required basis.

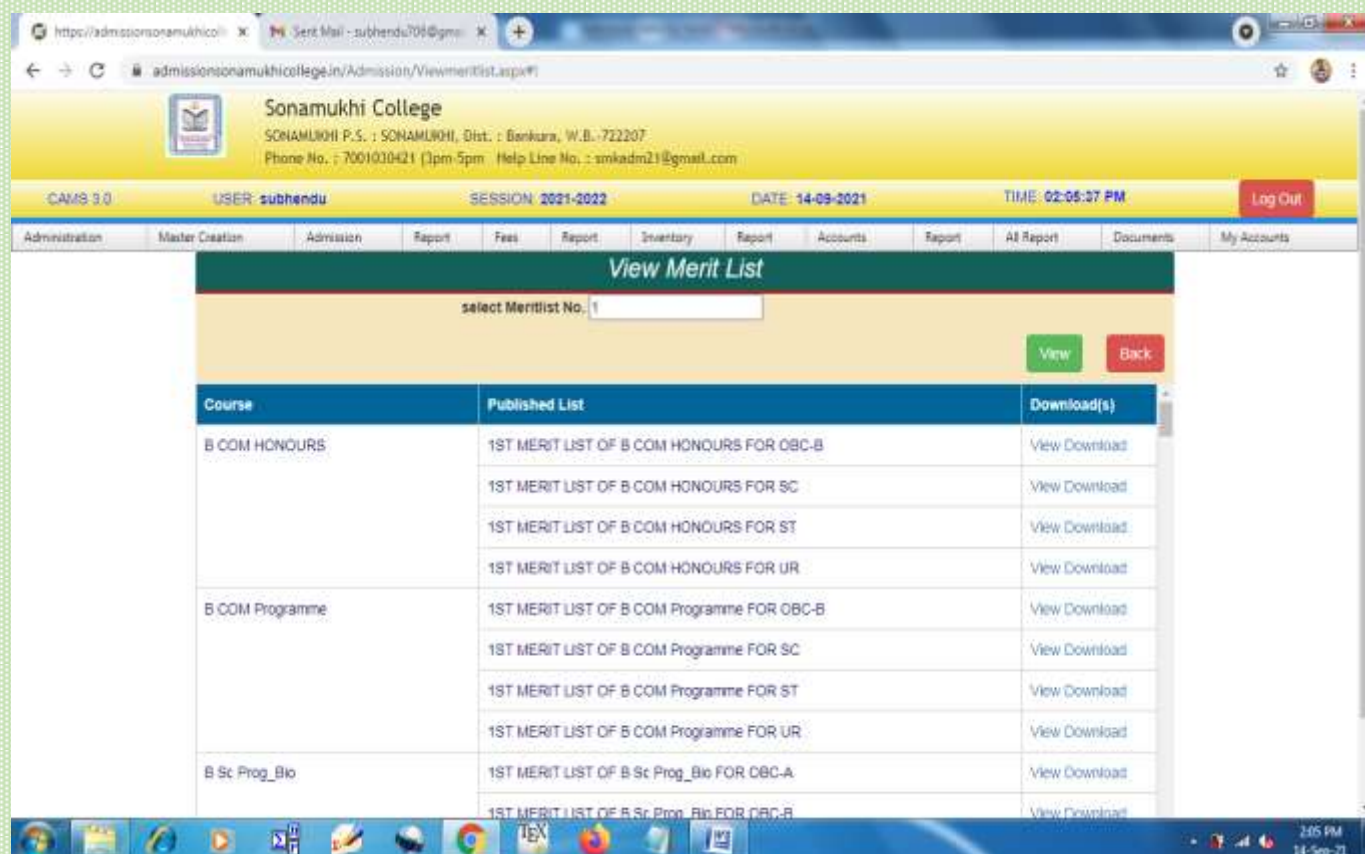

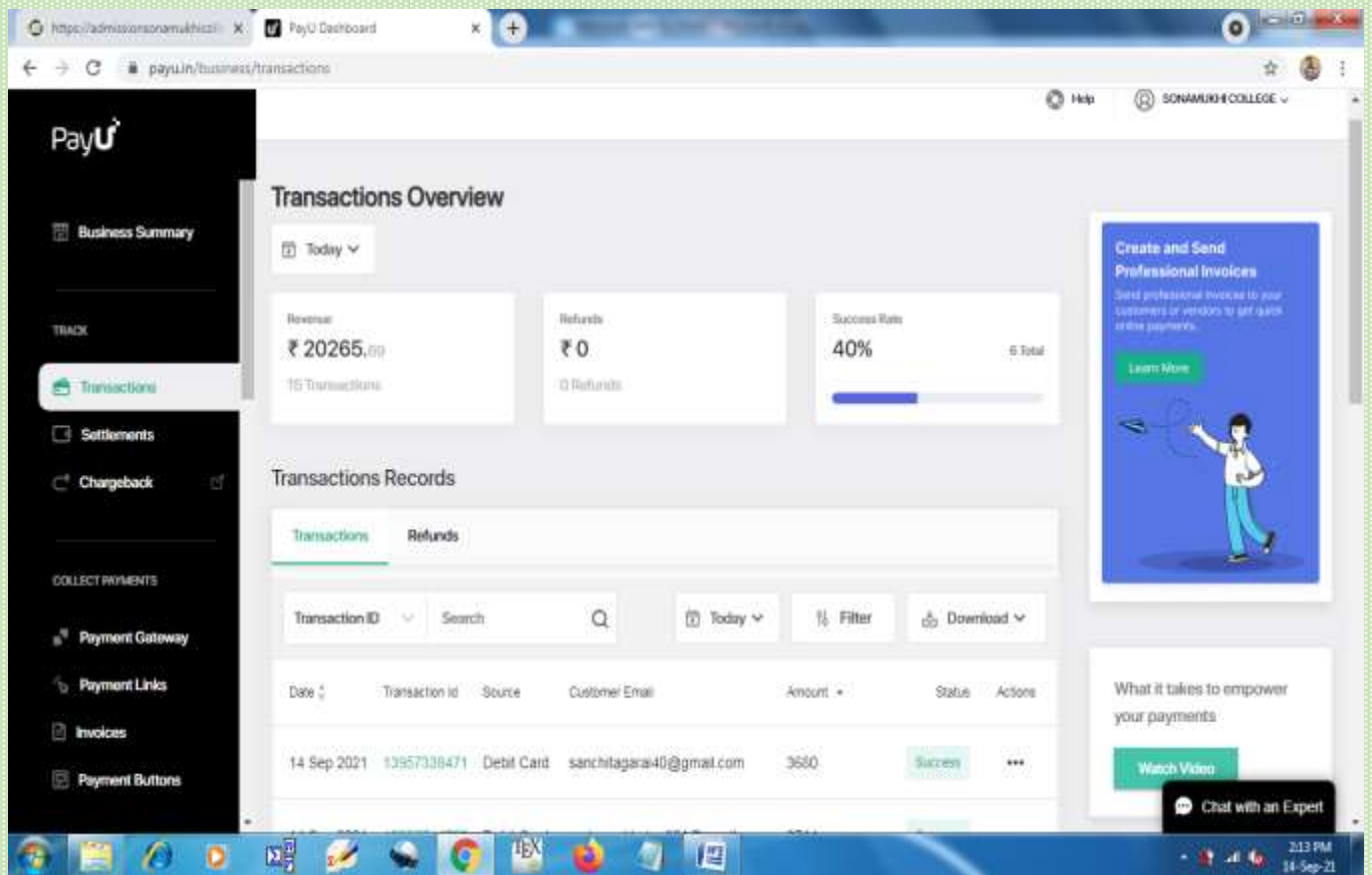

VISION

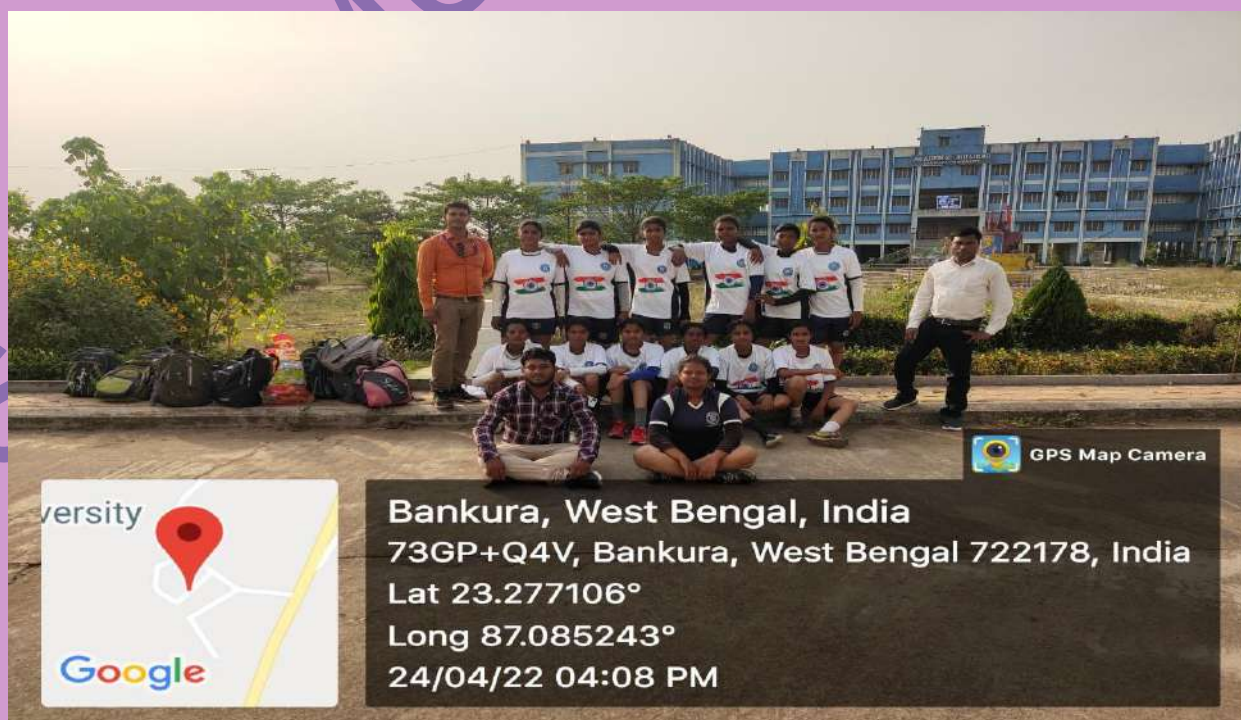

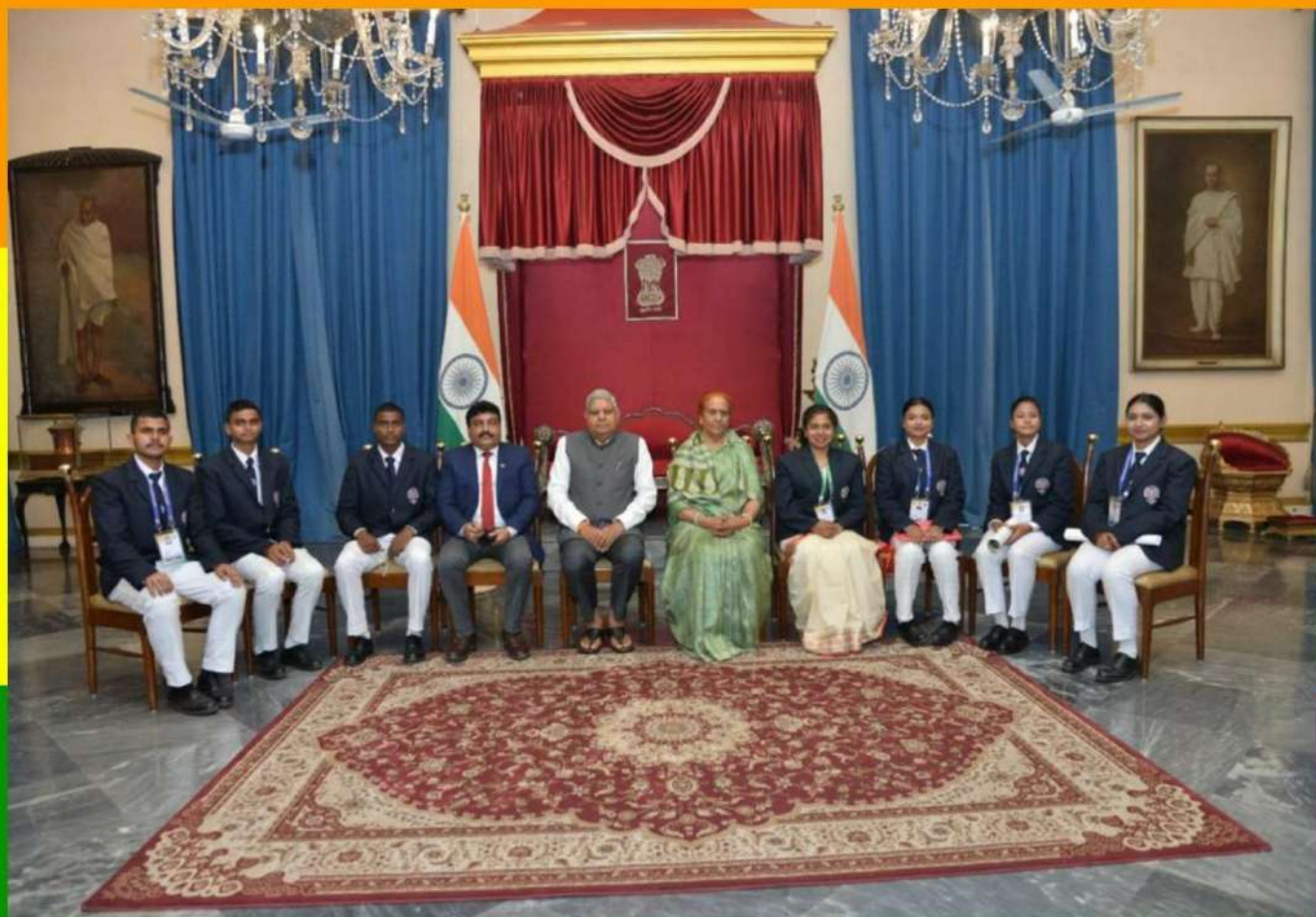

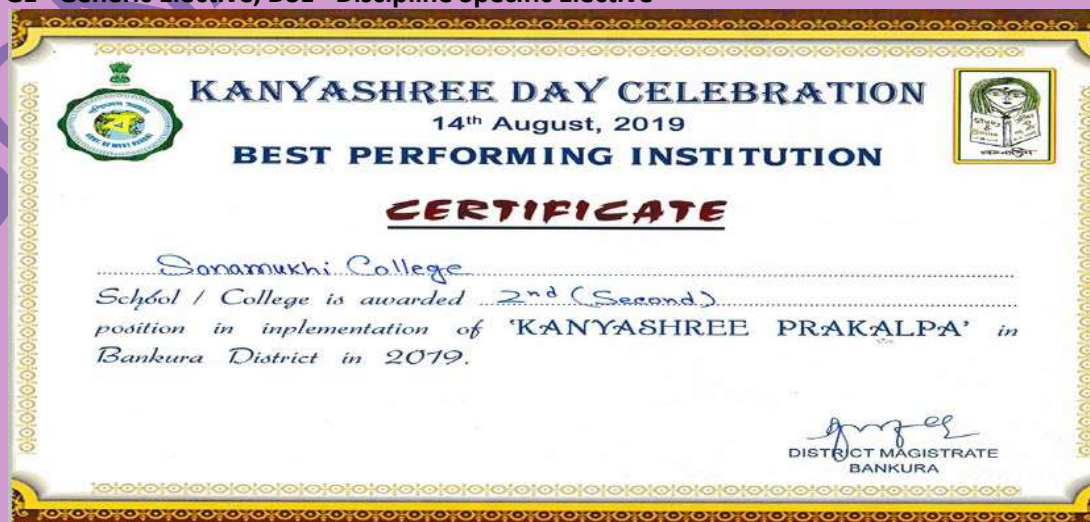

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Registration for Application: Online registration is mandatory for entering the admission procedure. Application for both the Honours and Programme courses can be made using one single registration.

Students who have passed H.S. or Equivalent Examination in 2020, 2021 and 2022 may apply for admission through the online registration. The link for registration is available in the home page of the college website <https://sonamukhicollege.ac.in>

Permanent and Own mobile number and email id of applicants are mandatory to fill up online application form for password confirmation as well as for future correspondences from Sonamukhi College and Bankura University (if got admitted).

During application candidates shall have to upload the scanned images of their Admit card and Marksheet of MP or equivalent Exam, Registration of H.S. or equivalent Exam, Marksheet of H.S. or equivalent Exam, Caste Certificate (if applicable) and P.H. Certificate (if applicable).

Activation of finally submitted online application will be done **AUTOMATICALLY** for merit list generation.

An applicant may apply in maximum four Honours subjects irrespective of faculty (science/Arts/Commerce) and maximum two Programme courses on the same online application form, if the candidate selects both option of Hons. & Programme.

The Eligibility Criteria for admission to different courses are available on Page- 23.

For applicants from Vocational Course: Students who have passed Vocational Engineering and Technology (with pass marks in Mathematics) equivalent to (10+2) level are eligible for admission to Pure Science Programme Course. Students who have passed Vocational Agriculture equivalent to (10+2) level are eligible for admission to Bio Science Programme Course. Students who have passed Vocational Business and Commerce equivalent to 10+2 are eligible for admission to Accountancy Honours Course.

Choice of Physical Education will be final after fitness test by the Department.

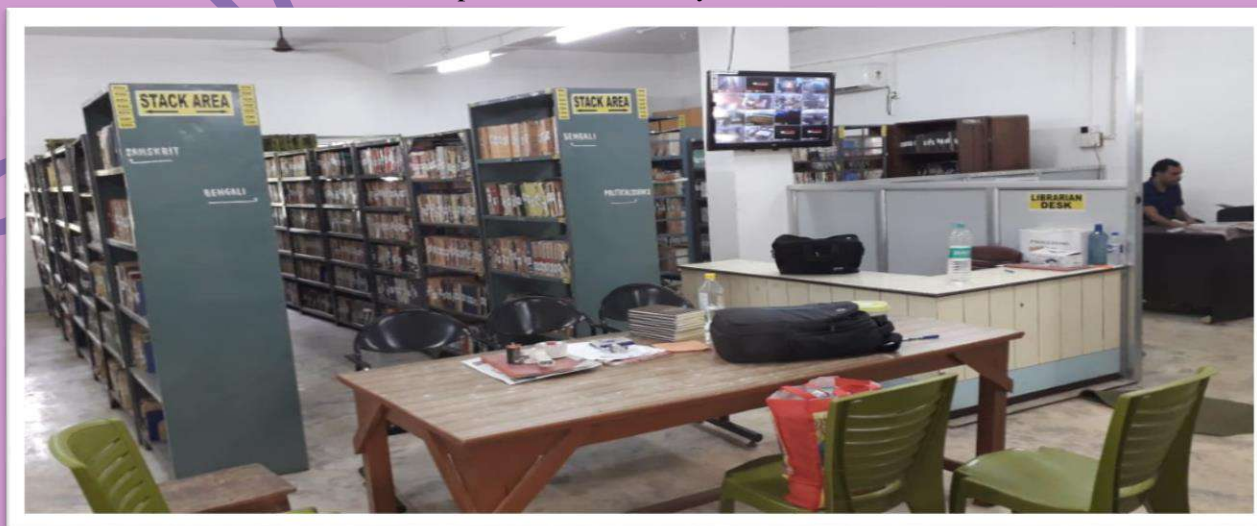
Library Services during COVID-19 for Students:
