In the glorious year of 1966, some noble souls assembled to lay the stone of Sonamukhi College under the leadership of Prof. Anantalal Patra. Late Bishnupada Dey and Late Shaktipada Dey extended their helping hand unconditionally by donating 5 acres land for the foundation as well as construction of the college. A large number of people stretched their kind hand by providing financial support for the establishment of the college. Irrespective of caste, creed, financial condition, the people showed their generosity by supporting the noble task with happiness and smile. The collective effort of the people belonging to all levels of society made it possible, the inception of Sonamukhi College as a holy place of higher education. Sonamukhi Block and its adjacent areas were densely populated. Poverty, ignorance, illiteracy, superstition and orthodoxy were their permanent companions. The initiative of imparting education to the first generation innocent learners of these areas was started in the three rooms of Sonamukhi Bindubasini Jubilee High School. The incessant and unflinching efforts achieved perfection on 17th August 1966 as the much expected approval letter from "The University of Burdwan" had been reached our college. Prof. Anantalal Patra, the founder principal, is no more with us but in all the stones, bricks, woods, plants and in everything within the college, his presence is felt, his contribution is realized. ## 16. Game and Sports Activities during 2021-2022:

The world of sports has grown tremendously over the past century, especially in colleges in India. Sports and games play an important part for the development of students. Kipping in mind Sonamukhi College always try to increase infrastructure and facilities of sports and game. Not only students but also college staffs together make their practice. College organized Annual sports for college students and staffs in every year. In athletic main events are those which are included in District level and University level Championship. Apart from these main events some entertaining events also conducted among students and staffs like, Musical Ball, Memory test, Spoon race, Breaking vessel etc. A lot of students and almost every staff participate in college sports. Position holder students are awarded with medal and college level certificate. Athletic team (men and women) for University and District level championship are selected from college annual sports. Physical education department take major part to conduct such events. All students of this department remain actively involved to conduct such event and almost all of them participate in any of the events. Sonamukhi college foot-ball, cricket, volley ball, badminton, Kho-kho team participate in Inter college district sports and games championship and university tournaments in every year. Students who got position ( $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ ) in district level become eligible for state level competition organized by DPI. Sonamukhi College organized Inter college state sports and games championship as and when directed by DPI. Apart from such regular sports activity, students are very much interested to play cricket with college teachers and many often they arrange teacher vs student cricket match. All staff and students of this college enjoyed very much. In this way a friendly relationship is maintained between teacher / staff and student of Sonamukhi College.
