
After a long interval we have implemented again remedial classes to enable slow learners to keep pace with academic developments. Now what we want is to integrate modern methods of teaching-learning.

Late Bishnupada Dey and Late Shaktipada Dey extended their helping hand unconditionally by donating 5 acres land for the foundation as well as construction of the college. A large number of people stretched their kind hand by providing financial support for the establishment of the college.
