A large number of people stretched their kind hand by providing financial support for the establishment of the college. Late Bishnupada Dey and Late Shaktipada Dey extended their helping hand unconditionally by donating 5 acres land for the foundation as well as construction of the college. A large number of people stretched their kind hand by providing financial support for the establishment of the college. Irrespective of caste, creed, financial condition, the people showed their generosity by supporting the noble task with happiness and smile. The collective effort of the people belonging to all levels of society made it possible, the inception of Sonamukhi College as a holy place of higher education.
