- Shiber Bandh is a village located 3.5km away from Sonamukhi College and comes under the Kochdihi Gram Panchayet. It is an adopted village by the Sonamukhi college NSS Unit-III.

Details of different programmes up taken

1. Inauguration of Aranyo Saptaho Celebration

Date : 14/07/2016

The inauguration ceremony of Aranya Saptaho celebration was occurred on 14th July 2016 at the college campus with the gracious presence of honourable Principal Sir, many teaching and non-teaching staff and 56 students.
