-----HISTORY

Some noble souls assembled in 1965-66 to give a shape of Sonamukhi College under the leadership of Prof. Anantal Patra. Late Bishnupada Dey and Late Shaktipada Dey unconditionally donated 5 acres land for the college. A large number of people blessed supports including financial for its establishment irrespective of caste, creed, financial condition. The collective effort of the people is the result of a holy place of higher education i.e. Sonamukhi College.

Sonamukhi Block and its adjacent areas were densely populated. Poverty, ignorance, illiteracy, superstition and orthodoxy were their permanent companions. The initiative of imparting education to the learners of these areas in the three rooms of Sonamukhi Bindubasini Jubilee High School. 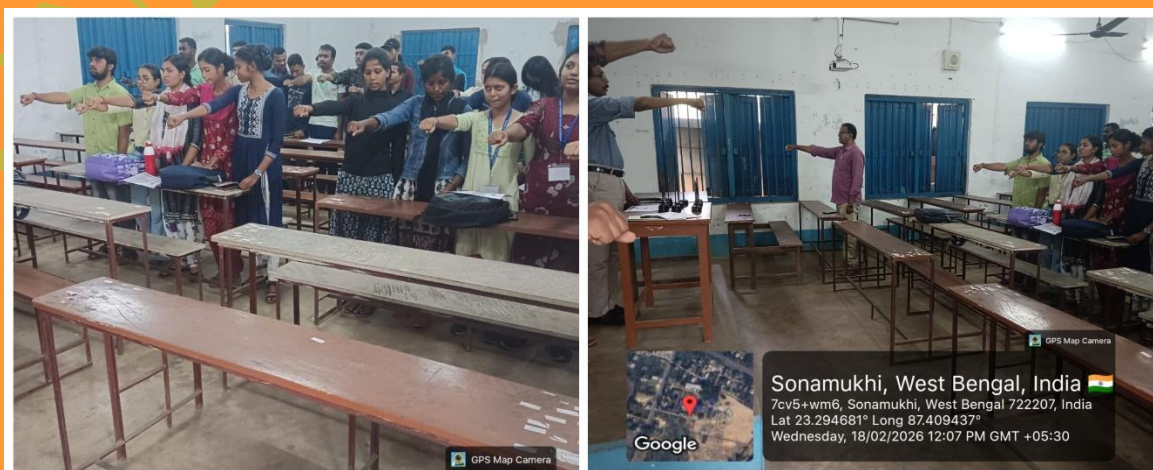

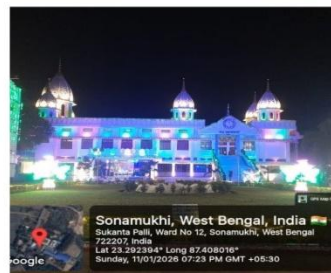

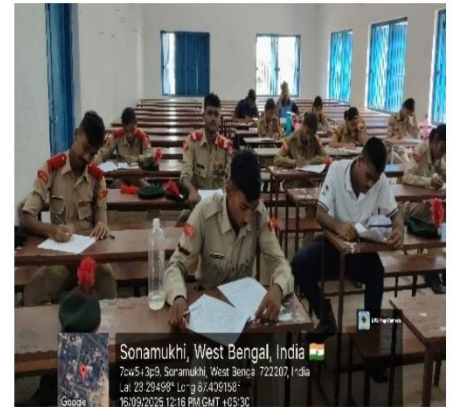

NCC Activities during 2025-26

OBJECTIVE

Imparting class room education to the students of various Major courses under the stream of Science, Arts and Commerce is the objective. Subsidiary objectives are improvement in campus atmosphere and canteen facilities. Beside the increase in number of books for new CBCS syllabi, provision for e-resources in teaching-learning-evaluation has been introduced to overcome the odd situations. ICT-enabled classrooms have been formed but to be increased more for improving the teaching-learning mechanism. A new dimension in the amalgamated activity with corporate spectrum is implemented in the last academic session. The soul objective is for doping of knowledge among the students which will be applicable in the practical world and they can serve the nation with pride.

Extension of infrastructure and domain of student benefit in the last Academic Year (2025-26)

In alignment with our mission to provide a holistic learning environment, the college successfully implemented several key infrastructure upgrades and student welfare initiatives during the 2025-26 academic session.

- 1. Administrative & Academic Scaling:** Construction on the first and second floors of the B.C. Roy Administrative Building is complete. This space now houses the new Principal's Office and 'Vidyasagar Hall'— a fully functional seminar room. Concurrently, construction on the third floor of Saktipada De Bhavan is underway to expand classroom capacity.
- 2. Green Energy Initiative:** Partnering with WBREDA, the college installed a 20kVA on-grid solar power system on the roof of the B.C. Roy Administrative Building, ensuring energy efficiency and sustainable, uninterrupted power campus-wide.
- 3. Library Enrichment:** Supported by a grant from the Higher Education Department, Government of West Bengal (Memo No. 74-HED-17014(99)/298/2025-CS SEC-Dept. of HE, dated 27.01.2026), the Central Library acquired a vast collection of new books valued at ₹4,64,900.
- 4. On-Campus Banking:** To facilitate seamless financial transactions for students, staff and also for the common people, the Sonamukhi Branch of the Bank of India has commenced operations within the campus, utilizing leased college infrastructure to generate institutional revenue.
- 5. Environmental Responsibility:** A Ground Water Level Monitoring (GWLM) station was installed on campus under the West Bengal Major Irrigation and Flood Management Project (WBMIFMP), contributing to regional water quality and resource tracking.
- 6. Skill-Centric Academics:** To boost student employability, the Central Library alongside the departments of Bengali, English, Sanskrit, Philosophy, Political Science, Economics, Commerce, Chemistry, Physics, and Zoology successfully introduced diverse Add-On courses this session.

Various Student Support System in the College

Scholarship: According to the eligibility and suitability of the students, they can apply for various governmental scholarship schemes like SVMCM, Aikyashree, Kanyashree, OASIS, Nabanna Scholarship, etc. They can apply also in various non-governmental scholarships like Jindal, and others. The college helps and guides so that one can get their applicable scholarship.

Student Credit Card Scheme: The students can apply for the Student Credit Card of WB Govt. as per rules of the scheme. The college organizes awareness camps to motivate students in applying the same.



West Bengal Govt. Free-Ship Scheme: The eligible students of Sonamukhi College get a Full-fee waiver and Half-fee waiver on the tuition fees according to the rules and guidelines of the scheme.

Students' Aid fund: Also, the poor and needy students get financial assistance from the college fund under the Students' Aid fund scheme.

Samadhan Aid Fund: Besides the various scholarships provided by the State Govt. and other organizations, Staff Council has formed 'Samadhan Aid Fund' to support the economically weaker students. - Financial award to a team: The amount of prize for participation in State/National Level will be double to that of previous level. In case of winner in State/National Level the amount will be rank-wise double.

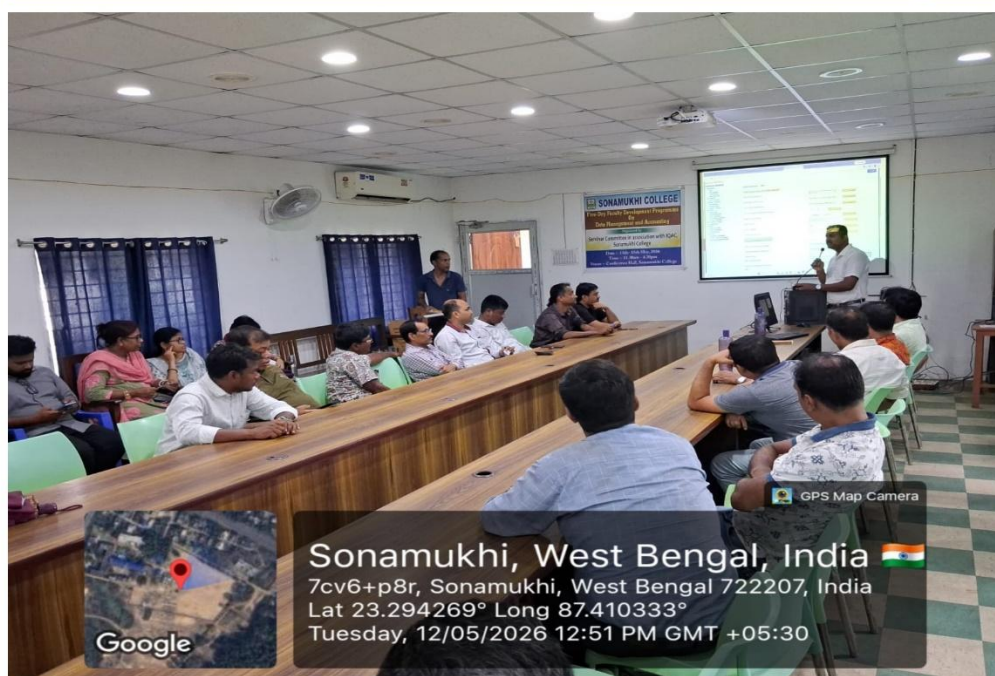

1. Student who opts to exit after completion of the first year will be awarded a **UG certificate** provided he/she has to earn minimum required qualification as per affiliating Bankura University.
2. Student who opts to exit after completion of the second year, will be awarded a **UG Diploma** provided he/she has to earn minimum required qualification as per affiliating Bankura University.
3. Students who wish to undergo a 3-year UG programme will be awarded **UG Degree in the Major discipline** after successful completion of three years and satisfying the minimum credit requirement notified by the affiliating Bankura University.
4. A four-year **UG Honours degree in the major discipline** will be awarded to those who complete a four-year degree programme and satisfy the minimum credit requirement set by the affiliating Bankura University. Students who wish to undertake research work at the 4th year will be awarded **UG Degree (Honours with Research)** in the concerned major subject after earning the required minimum credits set by the affiliating Bankura University.
5. A detailed course structure is given at the end of this prospectus. All the courses will run strictly following the curriculum, course structure, syllabus modules, assessment modalities and others rules and regulations prescribed by the Bankura University time to time. Details may be known from the College Office/ Bankura University Website: www.bankurauniversity.ac.in.

N.B. - Every student will have to take admission in 1st, 3rd, 5th and 7th semester separately.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE: Admission to various courses in 1st Semester of 3-Year or 4-Year UG Degree Programmes in Sonamukhi College will be conducted through the Centralized Online Admission Portal run by The Department of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal. During registration, the students have to opt for the courses available in Sonamukhi College to get admitted to the Sonamukhi College. During registration process, the students will be able to check the eligible courses from Sonamukhi College for their own. All the rules and regulations prescribed by the Higher Education Department, West Bengal, Bankura University and Admission Sub-Committee of Sonamukhi College will be strictly followed during the entire admission process.

Registration for Application: Online registration is mandatory for entering the admission procedure. Application for a maximum of 25 courses can be made using one single registration. Students who have passed H.S. or Equivalent Examination in 2026, 2025, 2024, 2023 and 2022 may apply for admission through the online registration. The link for registration is <https://wbcap.in>. It is also available in the home page of the college website <https://sonamukhicollege.ac.in>

Permanent and Own mobile number and email id of applicants are mandatory to fill up online application form for password confirmation as well as for future correspondences with Sonamukhi College and Bankura University (if got admitted).

During application candidates shall have to upload the scanned images of their Admit card and Marksheet of MP or equivalent Exam, Registration of H.S. or equivalent Exam, Marksheet of H.S. or equivalent Exam, Caste Certificate (if applicable) and PWD Certificate (if applicable).

Finally submitted online application will be activated **AUTOMATICALLY** for merit list generation.

An applicant may **apply for maximum 25 (Twenty five) Major courses** irrespective of faculty (science/Arts/Commerce) from a single registration.

During Registration, students have to arrange their selected courses according to their preference level. This is very important. If a student intends to take admission in Sonamukhi College, he/she has to arrange the courses of Sonamukhi College eligible to him/her in higher preference level. There will be options in the online portal for this arrangement.

During applying, the students are advised to carefully organize the opted courses according to their preference level. Note that, if any student gets selected in more than one course at any stage, he/she will be allowed to take admission only to the course with the highest preference level. Besides, after getting a chance to a particular course, whatever the preference number is, the candidate shall have to take admission for that particular course by completing the payment procedure. However, they will be able to activate the 'Upgrade' option to move to a higher preference level labelled course, if become selected in any future merit lists. But if a candidate does not accept the chance for his first time, he/she will not be considered for any future merit lists. Again, note that, through the upgrade process, the candidates will only be able to move to a higher preference labelled course, not to a lower labelled course.

Choice of Physical Education & Sports will be final after fitness test by the Department.

Common Information to Applicants:

- i. Reservation including PWD in the Intake capacity for various courses will be maintained strictly as per Govt. rules and will be automatically done by the software itself.
- ii. Merit-lists for the admission to various first semester courses during the Academic Year 2026-27 will be prepared obeying the rules mentioned in the head 'Merit list generation' on page 28. The calculation of merit point score or Ranking Index will be done by the software itself.
- iii. No marks will be deducted for applicants passed the 10+2 level exam. in previous years.
- iv. During registration process, students have to put their mobile number and email. Mobile no and email will be used by the college as well as by the University for communication purpose in future.

- vii. The candidature shall be cancelled at any time for false representation of any facts including the entry of marks of different subjects in H.S. or equivalent exam during the online application. All applicants are directed to check everything before final submission & Payment(s).
- viii. Always download soft copy of filled-in application form and payment receipts (if any). These will be auto generated. It is also advised to keep the hard copies of the said documents properly.
- ix. Candidates are advised to log in to their accounts and check their merit positions frequently in their own interest so that they do not miss any chances.
- x. **During the Upgradation phase, the candidate shall have to pay only the adjusting amount payable for that course (if required).**

Details of Merit List Generation: Subject wise and category wise merit list(s) will be published on the online admission website on the stipulated date & time. The merit list will be auto-generated depending on the seat capacity of a particular course and based on the following ranking rule. An SMS and email will be sent to the applicant's mobile and email id. After being selected for any particular course, the candidate has to confirm it by making the payment in the online admission portal within the stipulated date and time.

After getting a chance to a particular course with any preference number, if a candidate does not accept it in the online portal within the stipulated date and time, his/her chance will automatically be gone and he/she will not be considered further in the following merit lists for any course.

College authority will not be responsible for non-delivering of messages/mails in electronic mode for any reason. So, candidates are advised to log in to their accounts and check their merit positions frequently in their own interest so that they do not miss any chances.

Rules for preparing Merit List:

Merit lists will be prepared based on the total marks of best four subjects obtained in Higher Secondary or Equivalent Examination.

Tie-Breaking Rule: If the merit score of two or more number of applicants become same for any particular course during preparing the merit list, the total marks of best five subjects obtained in Higher Secondary or Equivalent Examination will be considered for ranking. Again if becomes a tie, the total percentage of marks obtained in the Class X level exam will be considered for ranking. However, if this score also becomes same, the date of births of the candidates will be considered for ranking.

Cancellation of Admission: Cancellation of admission and refund of admission fees (if any) will be made as per the rules sets in wbcap.in and according to the decisions of Sonamukhi College Admission Committee.

Eligibility Criteria and Subject Combination for Various Courses:

Those who have passed Vocational Business and Commerce at 10+2 level are eligible for admission to Commerce or Arts.

Note-1: Every student has to take one course from Major Discipline, one course from Minor Discipline, one Multi-Disciplinary Course, one Ability Enhancement Course (AEC), one Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) from the concerned Major Discipline and one Value Added Course in the 1st Semester. However, during Admission Procedure, applicants have to select only the Major Subject and Minor Subject in the online admission portal. The minor wise various combination for a particular Major subject will be visible in the admission portal. Please see the course structure at the end of this prospectus.

Note-2: The Intake capacities for minor courses are also limited. If a student cannot select a particular Minor subject in the portal during subject selection, it means the intake capacity for that particular subject has already been fulfilled. So, the student will be required to select an alternative subject as the minor subject.
